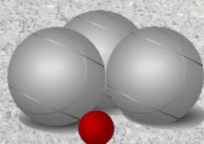

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS / CARNIVAL OVERVIEW – your quick guide for the big event

Welcome: The Executive Club Committee, Pétanque Sub Committee & Members of the Novar Gardens Bowling & Pétanque Club Inc along with our other SAPL (South Australian Petanque League) Clubs are looking forward with anticipation to warmly welcoming you to Adelaide for the 2020 National Championships / Easter Carnival of Petanque.

We hope that you will be able to join us for 4 days of quality competition, played in the right spirit & *'for the love of the game'* as this will be the unofficial tag for the event & is the underlying ethos for our club.

To help with the planning of your journey to Adelaide you may find some of the following information useful.



Location: The club is conveniently located at 489 Anzac HWY in the suburb of Novar Gardens which is adjacent to Adelaide's premier beach side suburb of Glenelg, locally referred to as 'The Bay'. By car you are approximately 3 minutes (2.5km) from the Jetty Road precinct at Glenelg, 16 minutes (8.7km) from Adelaide CBD, & 10 minutes (7.2km) from the Adelaide Airport Terminal.

Glenelg, its Jetty Road precinct, surrounding suburbs & the adjacent coastal strip have a multitude of restaurants, cafes, coffee shops & pubs within a concentrated area for you to avail yourself of whilst you are visiting.



Transport: The club is easily accessible by car, bus & tram. There are bus stops on either side of Anzac HWY within 200 metres of the club. The nearest tram stops are Stop 12 (Morphettville) Morphett Road, a 6-minute walk & Stop 13 (Glengowrie), Dunbar Terrace, a 7-minute walk.

Accommodation: There are many accommodation options in the local area including hotels, motels, apartments, B&B's, caravan parks, cabins etc. However, the area is quite popular with tourists & as it is Easter expect demand to be high. Please refer to attached list for some accommodation options within close proximity to the club. There are also many options a bit further afield including the City which is not really too far away, 16 minutes by car, 20 minutes by tram.



Catering: Light meals & snacks will be available for the duration of the tournament.

We will be offering a prepaid food card which will cover your main food costs for the entire event. This will be at a slightly reduced rate rather than if you pay as you go. It will also help us better plan catering requirements. Once event registrations are confirmed we will supply you with a menu & booking form to confirm if you require the food card or whether you prefer to pay as you go.



Social Function: Immediately following the end of the final event & presentations on Easter Monday we will be providing a 2 course meal, live music by local band 'The Rejuvenator's' & full bar facilities for those that want to wind down, socialise & enjoy each other's company after the 4 days of competition. After all, the camaraderie & friendships made is one of the best things about pétanque. We'd love you to join us to finish off the carnival in style.

The social function/meal combination will need to be prepaid in advance & you will be able to do so via the same booking form as for catering requirements. There will be a social function only (no meal option) available to those who don't wish to eat.



Parking: The club has some 50 car parks, enter off Ferguson Street which is a left turn off Anzac HWY heading towards the city. Then 1st right at the tennis club. Should pétanque club car park be full other options include the Glenlea Tennis Club car park (as you come in off Ferguson Street), or the PHOS Camden Football Club car park approximately 200 metres further up Anzac HWY towards the city.



Stay & Explore: We trust that you will enjoy your time with us & recommend you spend some extra time exploring the surrounding areas & see what they have to offer. Have a look at the attached information which lists some of the destinations you might choose to visit. These include metro, Barossa Valley, Southern Vales & Fleurieu Peninsula, Adelaide Hills region (all within an hour of Adelaide) & others a little further away like Kangaroo Island, Limestone Coast (including Coonawarra Wine Region) etc.

Visiting some of these areas may give you some appreciation of why we love where we live. We'd love for you to experience some of it as well.



Souvenir Pack: We will be producing an optional 'Nationals at Novar Gardens' souvenir pack which will be available for you to purchase as a memento of the event. Pack will include: Cap, Polo Shirt, Travel Mug & Supernovars Club Car Sticker—all for the amazing price of only \$60.00. You will be able to pre order & make payment via the same form as for catering & social function bookings.



Tournament Registration: Tournament player registration will once again be through the My Petanque Player Registration portal at [MyPetanque.com](https://www.mypetanque.com). Tournament registrations & payments are the responsibility of PFA & match administration will be under the supervision of PFA appointed officials.

Registrations for the tournament will open very soon. If you are planning to come, please register early to avoid possible disappointment. There will be a cap on event participants due to the finite number of pistes available.

Registration & payment for catering, social evening & souvenir pack will be controlled by Novar Gardens Bowling & Petanque Club.

Located 3 minutes from Glenelg and less than 20 minutes from City Centre



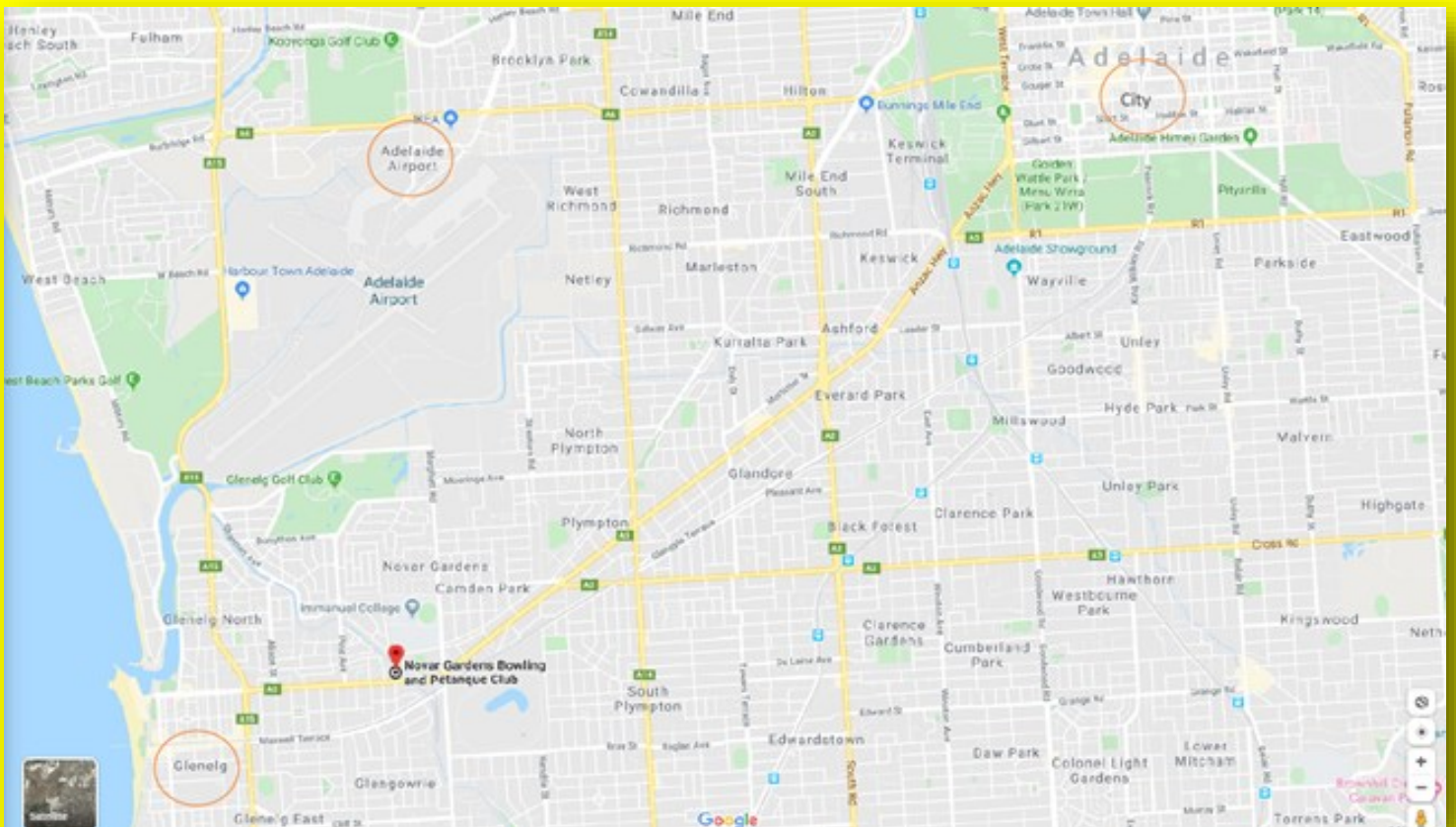

Taxi or Uber - 489 Anzac Highway, Novar Gardens. Carpark Entry off Ferguson St



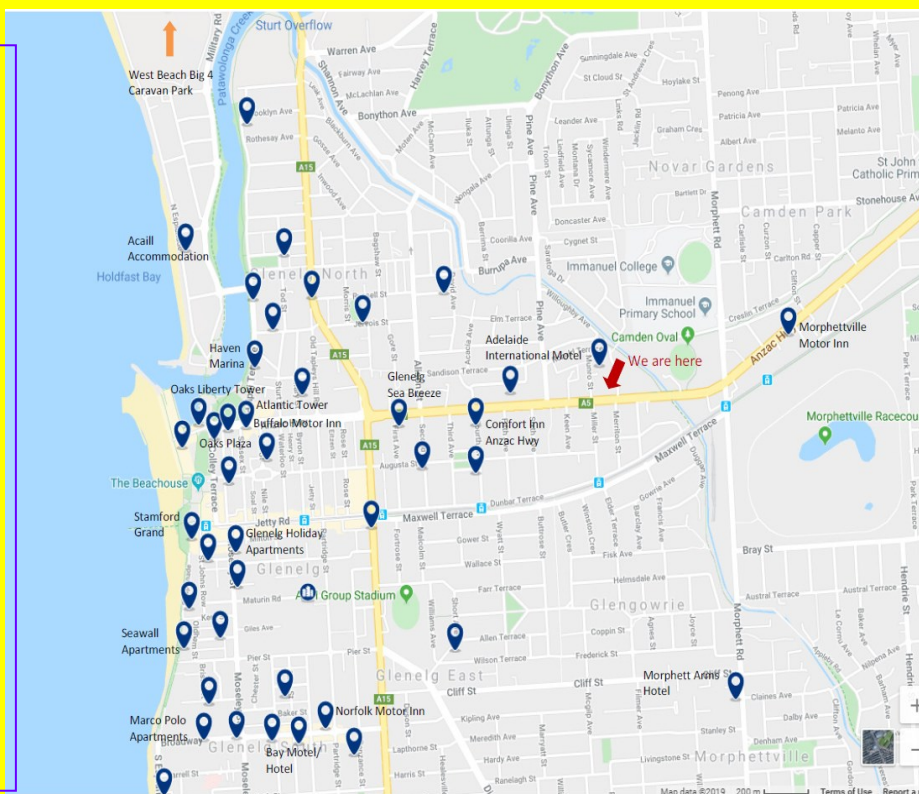
ACCOMMODATION

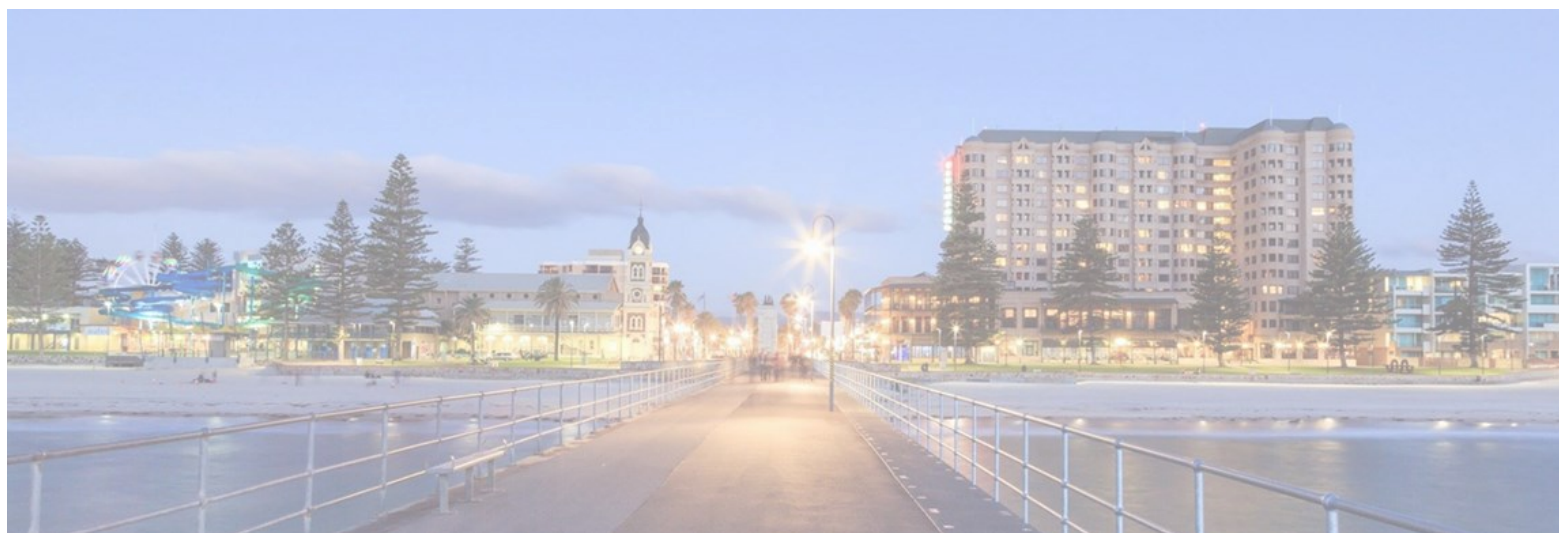
