TEAM REQUIREMENTS:

One team per Club.

Teams - comprising up to 12 people, there will be 9 players at any one time (of which there must be a minimum of 2 women) and up to 2 reserves,

Teams must fill the form supplied for the set before the commencement of the set.

Please see Rules that apply to reserves on page number two.

COST: - \$15.00 per player (ie. If you have 10 players \$150 if you only have 8 players \$120

Prizes for the winning Club -

1st \$ 120.00, + Trophy for the Club 2nd \$ 80.00, + Trophy for the Club 3rd \$ 60.00. + Trophy for the Club

Nomination of teams and reserves must be received at the latest 15th August 2021. Reserved players will not be accepted after the start of the games. (Email nominations to cjodun@westnet.com.au)

Format - Round Robin between 6 Clubs:

Set 1 Only -

1x Mixed Doubles (1 Woman)

1x Mixed Triples (1 Woman minimum or 2 women maximum per team).

1x Men's Triples

1x Women's Singles

All of the Set 1 games are played - (Each Club plays its Set 1 games against every other club).

Scoring:

Win: (Beat the other Club by between one or three games) = 4 points

Draw: (2 games all) = 2 points

Loss: No points

6 Teams/Clubs participation format:

15 sets timed games of 50 Minutes plus 1 end and 1 extra end if scores are tied, or to 13 points.

Sunday: Play starts 9.30am.

6. Uniforms - All players to wear team uniforms.

Rules for using Reserved Players during games -

- 1. Each team can have 2 substitutes of 1 man and 1 woman.
- 2. A player may be substituted during the game, upon completion of an end, as per international rules.
- 3. Substitute Man can be used as follows -
 - Men's Triples or Men's Doubles to replace one player during the game as above.
 - Mixed Triples or Mixed Doubles to replace a man as above.
 - To replace a man player if he is sick and unable to participate.
- 4. Substitute Woman can be used as follows -
 - Woman's Triples or Woman's Doubles to replace one player during the game as above.
 - Mixed Triples or Mixed Doubles to replace a woman as above
 - To replace a woman player if she is sick and unable to participate.
- 5. Mixed Triples only one player (Man or Woman) can be replaced in a game. In addition, if a team started with 2 men and 1 woman, a woman may also replace a man.
- 6. All teams (including reserves) must be listed on scoring sheet before the start of each game.
