



## **EASTERN SUBURBS PETANQUE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST INTERSTATE 2019 COMPETITION**

### **Club Facilities**

Eastern Suburbs Petanque Club is headquartered at the historic Unley Park Sports Club in Adelaide South Australia.

Conveniently located at 8 Northgate Street, Unley Park, approximately 20 minutes from the airport, the Unley Park Sports Club is just 10 minutes from the city between cosmopolitan Unley and King William Roads in Unley Park.

Unley Park Sports Club is a not for profit organisation and is totally operated by members, it has been providing facilities for sport and recreation since 1923. The club is now home to four sports clubs: petanque, croquet, tennis and lawn bowls.

The main clubroom has a fully stocked bar, modern kitchen, heating and cooling and a flexible open area with tables and chairs which can be configured in a variety of ways. It is licensed for up to 200 people and includes the following equipment:

- Roving microphone
- Inside/outside sound system
- Whiteboard with markers
- 65 inch TV including HTML cabling so screen can be used as a display for results
- DVD/CD Player
- Inside / outside PA system

### **Playing Area**

The petanque area is located in front of the club rooms handy to the kitchen, bar and toilets.

There are 16 pistes, all of which are 17m x 4.3m all marked with string lines. All pistes are fully lit with a catenary lighting system which complies with Australian Standard AS2560.2.1/2003 Sports Lighting. There is a scorer on each piste.

The pistes are predominantly 7mm gravel of various levels of cover and provide a challenging playing surface. There is plenty of bench seating around the playing area, all under cover. In addition there is a central grassed strip with a pergola to provide additional shade, this area is also set with tables and chairs. In the event of inclement weather we also have 3 marquees (2 x 3mx3m, 1 x 6mx3m) which can be used to provide additional shelter in the centre of the playing area.
